Township Engineer's Report
February 14, 2019

Nothing Changed for 3.14.19 meeting.

Active Projects:

1. Airport Road Bridge – Bridge design is complete. Draft bid package, plans, and specifications 90% complete. Awaiting coordination of the intermunicipal cost share agreement. Will need both Canton & Chartiers signatures on the DEP permit application.
2. Log pile Run Restoration – Schematic design is in progress. "Bank pinning" is scheduled in the next week or two to measure stream sediment loading and potential MS4 offset credits for a restoration project here.
3. New Township Rec Center – Draft construction plans provided for Twp review and feedback. Proceeding with shell building package for bidding. Will need to review some finish and specification details with the Board before finalizing.
4. Brockway Glass HOP for New Road – As directed by the Township, we have submitted a request through PennDOT EPS and withdrawn the HOP application on Canton's behalf.
5. Zoning Amendment – Possible zoning map amendment in progress at the Board's direction. We will provide engineering support as necessary.

Inactive Projects:

6. PA American Water ReChlorination Tank – Nothing new. HCEG is completing site inspections only as needed basis or as requested by PA American. Phone conferences are hosted monthly by their project staff and our engineer Lara MacAulay is included.
7. McClay Rd Bridge – Nothing new. Inspected and recommended 3-Ton weight restriction until superstructure replacement can be scheduled. Road Dept has posted. Will this be a 2019 project?
8. Weirich Ave PennDOT Drainage – Nothing new. We are awaiting plan info from previous PennDOT discussion. Once we receive them we will prepare the necessary plans and file the HOP application through EPS if/when needed.
