Discussion on Running Brooke land development and wall permit. Dave went over what still needs done for approval and Chris sent letter on what is still needed for the wall permit.



Active Projects:

1. **Price Property** – We have completed a site inspection of the property. Found charred structural wood members in garage.
2. **Berthel Bridge** – Received 3 bid this afternoon. The low bid was for \$28,000 from Gary Metzinger. Recommend Township to proceed with this contract.
3. **Brockway Glass (Running Brooke II)** - Completed Land Development review from applicants 2nd submission and issued comment letter. Majority of the comments deal with the land consolidation.
4. **McClay Bridge** – Reviewing project for eligibility in the Low Volume Road Grant.
5. **Dollar General** - Received Land Development Submission and will begin the review.

6. **Fettis Subdivision** – Sewage Planning documents complete and submitted to sewage council. Landowner will need to schedule an inspection with the SEO. Nothing new
