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Township Engineer's Report August 13, 2020

Active Projects:

1. Berthel Bridge – Work completed.
2. Mulberry Bridge – Draft of the bid specifications completed. Working with paint rep to finalize paint specifications.
3. Airport Bridge – Draft of the bid specifications completed. Working with paint rep to finalize paint specifications.
4. McClay Bridge – Design in progress and are estimating structural design to be complete by September.
5. Jefferson Ave. Park – Contractor mobilized back on site with rock crusher and demo is in progress. Inquired with Redevelopment Authority on timeline for completion. The rock crusher is currently down for repairs, but foundation void should be leveled by end of next week.



6. Price Property – Calculated quantities and cost estimate to repair structure.
7. Dollar General – Received a complaint from the rear neighboring property owner who was concerned with the location of the storm basin. Completed a visual site visit on August 4, 2020. Current work at the stormwater basin was in the location as shown on the plan. Reported back to landowner on the findings.



8. 441 Malone Ridge – Landowner stopped in office inquiring on the requirements of remediating their property and the details of placing fill on property.
9. 8 Skylark Drive - Supplied an update to Mr. Kengor on review of the storm drainage system



10. 844 I&I – Coordinating flow monitoring with Drnach Environmental and Sewer Authority.
