3. **Custom Tool & Grinding** – Reviewed applicants Land development plans and issued comment letter.
4. **Park Pavilion** – Worked with the contractor on details for trim and finishes. Concession stand countertops were not included in base package. Township will need to purchase these locally with the hot water tank and concession sink.
5. **Gorden Ave Easement** – Review the site and will start to draft the easement for the new storm system
